Globally Harmonized System

New Jersey has adopted both Right-to-Know (RTK) regulations and OSHA's Hazard Communication Standard. OSHA has updated its HazCom regulations include the new Globally Harmonized System (GHS) of chemical labeling and hazard evaluation. Every employee must be trained in the new GHS labeling regulation by December 2013. This online course will meet training requirements for RTK, HazCom and GHS. Content includes how to read a label using safety data sheets and basic chemical terminology. Employees' rights and responsibilities under RTK are also reviewed.
