



IMPLICIT BIAS IN THE WORKPLACE TRAINING

Participants will develop an understanding of how implicit bias impacts the work environment. Individual stereotypes and unconscious beliefs can discourage employee participation in solving problems, thwart imagination, and lead to a reduction in organization productivity. Additionally, when left unmanaged, such biases create a toxic work environment that may become unsafe while also fostering workplace discrimination allegations.
